

DRUG EDUCATION

The Governing Board recognizes the importance of establishing a comprehensive drug education program for pupils in Grades K-12 which is a component of a comprehensive K-12 health education program. The Drug Education Program should consist of the following components:

1. Sequential instruction from kindergarten through Grade 12 on the nature and effects of the use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs will be presented.
2. Professional development will be provided for staff members so they can implement effective local alcohol, tobacco, and other drug training programs.
3. This professional development will include prevention curriculum designed to provide recognition of symptoms and appropriate interventions.
