DRUG EDUCATION

The Governing Board recognizes the importance of establishing a comprehensive drug education program for pupils in Grades K-12 which is a component of a comprehensive K-12 health education program. The Drug Education Program should consist of the following components:

- 1. Sequential instruction from kindergarten through Grade 12 on the nature and effects of the use of alcohol, tobacco, and other drugs will be presented.
- 2. Professional development will be provided for staff members so they can implement effective local alcohol, tobacco, and other drug training programs.
- 3. This professional development will include prevention curriculum designed to provide recognition of symptoms and appropriate interventions.
