


Family Elementary Survey Results

On October 27, 2020, CUSD staff sent out a survey to gather feedback on our health and safety measures and our in-person learning programs so we can continue to improve the educational experience for all of our students. The survey closed on November 3, 2020.

- 5,933 survey responses were provided

My child is learning in their instructional program




My child's current instructional program has improved as compared to the distance learning program from Spring 2020




For families whose children are in program C, please indicate how effective the instructional time with the teacher has been in providing support in literacy and numeracy for your child




