ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Language Builders program is designed to provide intervention for preschool aged children. The program's primary focus is on the development of receptive and expressive language skills in a natural context.

Language Builders students meet with a Speech and Language Pathologist (SLP) for intervention in a preschool classroom setting of up to 7 children. The SLP addresses

understanding and use of the following language areas:

- semantics (concepts, vocabulary, and following directions)
- syntax/morphology (grammar)
- pragmatics (social language)
- speech sound production

 (articulation and
 conversational intelligibility)



The stimulating small group environment allows the SLP to address individual needs while encouraging positive peer interactions. Language-based, directed activities incorporate fine motor, gross motor, attending and



pre-academic skills with an emphasis on turn-taking, following directions, vocabulary and concept development, and language expansion. The presence of peers provides the benefit of hearing and using language to request, protest, greet, explain and narrate with peers in a more natural setting. The SLP facilitates language and social skills by modeling, prompting, cueing, reinforcing and encouraging interaction.
