## SAN DIEGO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BID NO. GD19-0545-03, CLASSROOM SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY, ENGINEERING, ART, AND MATH (STEAM) SUPPLIES – SCHOOL SPECIALTY, INCORPORATED

2. Brief description of what the topic involves (**if supporting information is not included**):

Approval to utilize the San Diego Unified School District Bid No. GD19-0545-03, for the purchase of classroom science, technology, engineering, art, and math (STEAM) supplies from School Specialty, Incorporated, under the same terms and conditions of the public agency's contract. This contract provides competitive set pricing for STEAM supplies, as needed, by the District. Annual expenditures utilizing this contract are estimated to be \$450,000, funded by various departments, sites, and projects requesting product. Actual expenditures may vary depending on District needs and the availability of funding. School boards have the authority to "piggyback" on another public agency's bid, per Public Contract Code \$20118, when it is in the best interest of a district. It is often advantageous to utilize piggyback bids when contract items are identical to the District's specifications. Using piggyback contracts saves time and often provides lower prices than a single jurisdiction would be able to obtain.
